The Power of Play - The Power of Lekotek

Just Like Andy in Toy Story, we all have fond memories of favorite childhood toys. Imagine you're a child who wants to turn on a battery operated toy or play a computer game with a friend. But perhaps due to weak motor skills you are unable to activate the on/off switch or use the mouse. At Lekotek, toy and computer adaptations make it possible for every child to experience success and learn along the way. Lekotek provides accessible play, adapted toys and technology, information and resources to facilitate inclusion in family and community life.



The word "Lekotek" comes from the Swedish work "lek," meaning play, and the Greek suffix "tek" meaning library. Loosely translated, Lekotek means play library, but to the hundreds of families Lekotek serves, it is much more. While the hour session is all about play, the by products are the development of cognitive skills such as phonics, reading, math and problem solving. In addition, children develop fine motor skills and computer literacy.

Since 1983, Lekotek of Georgia has made a difference for more than 6,500 families traveling from metro Atlanta, rural Georgia and beyond.

Last year, 728 children with a wide range of disabilities such as autism, cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, hearing and/or vision loss, spina bifida, mitochondrial disorders and genetic conditions benefited. And below, Amir and Daniel are helping Bob the Builder paint the fence simply by touching the touch window built into the computer monitor.

Lekotek's main center is in Atlanta with five satellite locations in Duluth, Alpharetta, Kennesaw, Fayetteville and Gainesville. We look forward to reaching additional children who need our help.
